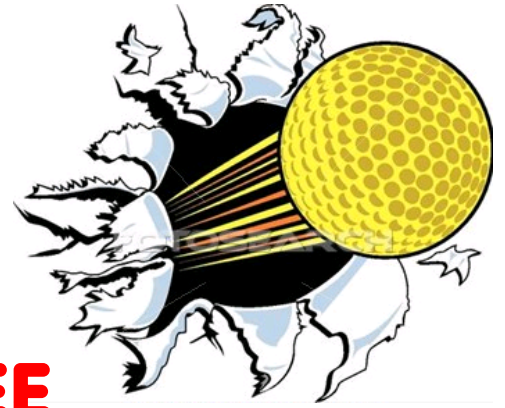

YELLOW BALL CHALLENGE



TEAMS OF THREE

INDIVIDUAL STABLEFORD

BUT WITH A FUN TWIST TO GET YOUR TEAM SCORE ON EACH HOLE

SATURDAY 8TH MAY

- You will play in a team of three and on each hole two players will play with a white ball and one person will play with a yellow ball.
- The two players with “white” balls tee off from the White Tees. The one person using the “Yellow” Ball gets to tee off from the Yellow Tees
- Each player in the team must play the yellow ball on 6 holes each
- Now the fun bit! Your team score for the hole is the sum of stableford points scored by the white ball multiplied by the yellow ball
(i.e. the yellow ball is very important—if the yellow scores no points on a hole the team scores no points for that hole—equally if both white balls fail to score the team score is also zero)
- Don't worry—we have a computer programme that will calculate the scores for you—all you need to do is put down your gross scores on the special scorecards
- Example Scores in the table below
- Return with the same Yellow Ball your team started with for a bonus 4 points

	Stableford Points					Comments
	White Ball 1	White Ball 2	White Ball 1 + White Ball 2	Yellow Ball	Team Score (White x Yellow)	
Hole 1	2	2	4	3	12	Big Score - all three balls score with the yellow on a nett birdie to multiply by 3
Hole 2	3	0	3	1	3	Only one white ball scores and the Yellow Ball is on a Nett Bogey so multiplier is only 1
Hole 3	0	0	0	2	0	Both white balls fail to score - so the yellow ball is multiplied by zero - No points
Hole 4	2	3	5	0	0	Both white balls score but the yellow ball fails to score - no points
